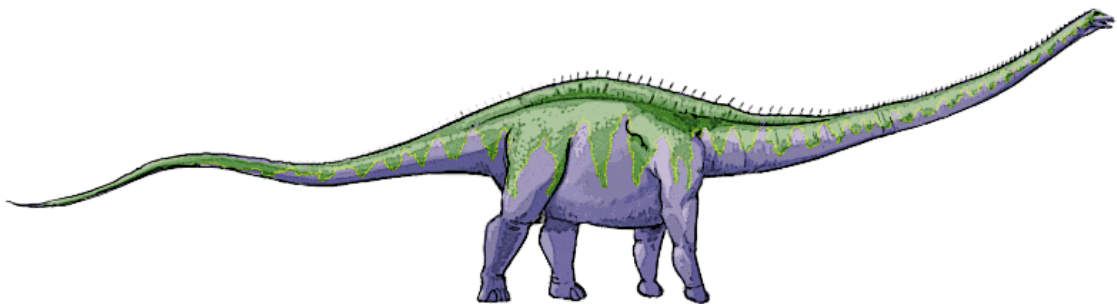

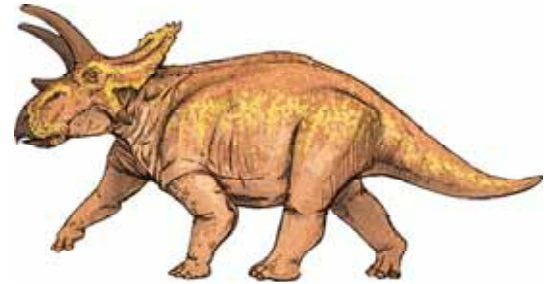

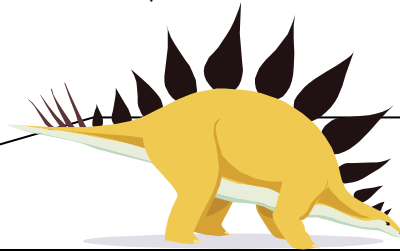
Add 'ed' to these words. Use the rules below to help you!
